The film, "Living with Nature - The ROLAND PLOCHER® integral-technik", will celebrate its global premiere at 7:00 PM CET on YouTube.

For more than three years, the filmmakers accompanied farmers, water specialists, municipalities, educators and international users who have been working with PLOCHER products for many years. The result is a film told consistently from real-life practice - not from the laboratory.

A Technology That Activates Natural Processes - Instead of Fighting Them


Through real examples, the film shows how water and soil problems can be solved through informed materials:

- · natural swimming ponds and lakes that remain clear without chlorine
- slurry that turns into liquid humus
- soils that store water and carry plants through weather extremes
- · manure heaps that mature into fine-crumbled, living fertilizer without turning
- buildings whose indoor climate is completely transformed by a **plocherwara** installation

Everywhere, the underlying idea is the same:

"Work with nature, not against it."

The film also paints a personal portrait of company founder Roland Plocher (1940-2021), who dedicated his life to understanding water, soil and energy flows. His non-magnetic information transfer is based on decades of observing natural processes and is applied worldwide.

SHORT VERSION

"Living with Nature - The ROLAND PLOCHER® integral-technik" follows farmers, water experts and companions of Roland Plocher. The film shows how informed materials clean water, turn slurry into liquid humus and regenerate soils - without chemicals, without additional energy, in alignment with natural laws.

A documentary about observation, trust and true vitality.

MEDIUM VERSION

"Living with Nature - The ROLAND PLOCHER® integral-technik" is a documentary about a technology that works in accordance with natural laws instead of fighting them.

We accompany farmers, consultants, municipalities and institutions who have been working with PLOCHER products for many years:

- · natural swimming ponds without chlorine, with crystal-clear water and freshwater mussels as bioindicators
- · slurry that becomes valuable liquid humus instead of smelling and emitting gases
- · soils that store water, stop erosion and protect plants during drought
- · buildings whose water and indoor climate are completely transformed by plocherwara systems

Inside a school building, a biotope supported by a **plocherwara** system ensures clear water, healthy indoor air and an entirely new learning atmosphere.

In agriculture, the film shows how "problem substances" become resources again:

- · slurry that becomes homogeneous, almost odorless and plant-compatible liquid humus instead of waste
- manure heaps that mature into fine, living fertilizer without turning or heavy machinery
- soils that retain water like a sponge, stop erosion and sustain plants through weather extremes

Instead of decay, odor and nutrient loss, a cycle emerges in which nutrients remain where they belong: in the soil, the plants and feed quality.

Farmers report storable, aromatic hay, vital animals and operational flexibility they never achieved with conventional chemistry.

Parallel to this, the film tells the story of **Roland Plocher** – an unconventional thinker who trusted his perception and sought to "understand and copy nature," as he put it. His non-magnetic information transfer acts as a catalyst: it reminds water and soil of their optimal structure – without force, without pressure, without energy consumption.

Colleagues, friends and companions portray a man who never worked "for the money," but for solutions. Someone who said: "Do good – and earn money doing it."

The film is both invitation and call to action: to work with nature instead of against her, to address causes instead of fighting symptoms – and to inspire agriculture, water management and environmental stewardship to be rethought responsibly in the coming decades.
